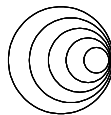

Such facilities furnished shall be designed to deliver shipments to the carrier with an adequate suction pressure at the maximum pumping capacity of the carrier's pumping station at Macungie, Pennsylvania when shipments are delivered from storage for shipment to final destinations.

- (i) when the monthly volume is less than 70,000 barrels, the Base Rate in Table 1 shall apply.
- (ii) when the monthly volume is equal to or more than 70,000 barrels, the base rate in Table 1 shall apply to all volumes up to 70,000 barrels, and the Excess Volume Rate in Table 2 shall apply to all barrels equal to or greater than 70,000 barrels.
