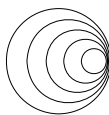

- (2) Application of Rates:  
 When operating conditions permit, Buckeye Pipe Line Company, L.P. will transfer specified products through its existing manifold facilities to and/or from terminals, refinery tankage, and pipelines of any other company directly connected to Carrier's manifold facilities at the rate shown herein. For transfers in the Toledo, OH area, rate (A) shall apply to transfers involving only the Carrier's manifold facilities; rate (B) shall apply to transfers involving its existing mainline pipes.

### Application of Contract Rate in Table 4:

Rates in Table 4 will apply to any shipper who executes a written contract with the Carrier to transport refined products between the origin and destination shown subject to the following conditions:

- a) Shipper agrees to tender a minimum quantity of one million two hundred seventy thousand five hundred (1,277,500) barrels during each contract year of a minimum two year contract agreement period.
- b) A minimum quantity of seventy-five thousand (75,000) barrels, and a maximum quantity of one-hundred fifty thousand (150,000) barrels will apply to each calendar months shipments.
- c) A monthly deficiency payment equal to the difference between the contract rate in Table 4, and the base rate between the origin and destination in Table 3 of this tariff, will apply to any monthly or contract year deficiency.
- d) A contract year deficiency payment equal to the difference between the contract rate in Table 4, and the base rate between the origin and destination in Table 3 of this tariff, will apply to any contract year volume deficiency. Credit for any monthly deficiencies paid during the contract year will be applied to any annual deficiencies due.
- e) Any volumes in excess of the one-hundred fifty thousand (150,000) barrel monthly maximum will be transported at the base rate shown in Table 3, and will not count toward the contract year minimum commitment.
