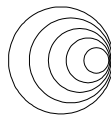

Application of Incentive Volume Rates in Table 1:

Rates in Table 1 apply to volumes to any single terminal at Brecksville, Ohio, of any shipper whose shipments during a calendar quarter (see definitions) meet both of the following criteria:

- (i) total long haul shipments on Buckeye Pipe Line Company, L.P. exceed 5,000,000 barrels, and
- (ii) volumes shipped between all origins and any single terminal at Brecksville exceed 1,600,000 barrels.
