- (1) Exception to FERC Tariff No. [W] 28.9.0 28.6.0 Item 45: In lieu of the loss allocation provisions of Item 45(B), a volume deduction of one quarter of one percent (0.25%) of net receipt quantities will be made to cover evaporation, interface and other normal operating volume losses. This exception applies to all pipeline transportation movements between the origins and destinations in the Table Of Rates.
- (2) Chicago Complex consists of the following locations: East Chicago, Lake County, Hartsdale, Lake County, and Lake George, Lake County. In this table, East Chicago is the applicable location.
